

#### **250-5-.04 General Requirements: Funeral Director. Amended.**

(1) An applicant for licensure as a funeral director must satisfy the following requirements:

- (a) be at least 18 years of age at the time of application; and
- (b) be of good moral character;
- (c) have graduated from a high school or have earned a general education development certificate.

(2) An applicant for licensure as a funeral director shall make written application to the Board on forms which will be provided upon request, shall submit the appropriate fee, and shall provide the following:

- (a) proof of valid licensure as an embalmer in the State of Georgia.
- (b) an affidavit which states that the apprentice assisted with 50 funerals and which specifies the names and dates of death.

(3) An application for licensure as a funeral director shall be reviewed only after it is complete. This application shall ask questions regarding the applicants conviction of a felony or misdemeanor and violations or sentences under the First Offender Act. An application must be completed at least 15 days prior to a Board meeting, and the Board shall accept or reject each application by majority vote.
